On day four, you'll descend into the majestic Ngorongoro Crater, a UNESCO World

Heritage Site teeming with wildlife including the rare black rhino. The final day includes

a cultural visit to a Maasai village and a peaceful nature walk through the lush Rau

Forest. This safari offers comfortable midrange lodges, well-balanced meals, and

seamless logistics for an unforgettable Tanzanian experience.

**Itinerary** 

Day 1: Arrival in Arusha

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) or Arusha Airport, you will be met

by your safari representative and transferred to your hotel in Arusha. Depending on your

arrival time, you can relax at the lodge or explore the town at your leisure. This is a

great time to rest and prepare for your safari adventure starting the next day.

Accommodation: Midrange lodge in Arusha

Day 2: Arusha to Tarangire National Park

After breakfast, depart Arusha and drive to Tarangire National Park, known for its large

elephant population, ancient baobab trees, and diverse wildlife. Enjoy a full-day game

drive through the park, spotting lions, zebras, giraffes, and many bird species. You'll

stop for a picnic lunch inside the park. Later in the afternoon, transfer to your lodge near

Karatu for dinner and overnight.

Meals: Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Midrange lodge near Karatu

Day 3: Karatu to Lake Manyara National Park

After breakfast, drive to nearby Lake Manyara National Park for a day of game viewing.

The park is known for its lush forests, soda lake filled with flamingos, and the chance to

see tree-climbing lions. You'll also spot hippos, baboons, elephants, and a wide variety

of birdlife. Return to your lodge in Karatu in the late afternoon for dinner and overnight

stay.

Accommodation: Midrange lodge near Karatu

Day 4: Ngorongoro Crater Safari

Start the day early with breakfast, then head to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area.

Descend into the crater for a half-day safari in one of the world's most unique

ecosystems. Here, you may spot the Big Five, including black rhinos, lions, and

buffaloes. After a scenic picnic lunch in the crater, ascend and return to Karatu for

dinner and overnight.

## Day 5: Maasai Village Visit and Rau Forest Walk - Return to Arusha

On your final day, visit a traditional Maasai village for a cultural exchange and to learn about their lifestyle and traditions. Afterwards, enjoy a nature walk in Rau Forest, where you may see monkeys, forest birds, and rice paddies. After lunch, you will be transferred back to Arusha, marking the end of your safari.
