

#### BAAS 1

# 3 Hours Nairobi City Tour

The tour covers the modern city center, the colorful City Market. Parliament Buildings, the Railway station and the Renowned National Museum where there are spell bindings displays of the early man, tribal regalia and the Fauna of Kenya, a visit to the adjacent Snake park is also included.

#### BAAS 2

#### 4 Hours Nairobi National Park

The tour starts at 2:00p.m. This unique Sanctuary is just a few kilometers from Nairobi bustling City Centre, but despite its proximity there are many species of mammals that can be found there including four of the Big Five. The tour returns to the City Centre by sundown. Private tour of the same can be organized in the morning for groups.

#### BAAS 3

#### 3 Hours Karen Blixen and the Giraffe Centre

Depart in the morning or in the afternoon. Drive towards the Ngong Village to the Karen Blixen Museum, for many years this was her home. Later proceed to the Giraffe Centre to see a feed the famous Rothschild Giraffes.

#### BAAS 4

#### **Carnivore Experience**

Guaranteed daily at 12:30p.m.and 7:00 p.m. Nairobi has many restaurants offering varieties of cuisine. We recommend a dinner or lunch at the Carnivore which is famous for the succulent stew and barbecue dishes of Game meat as an excellent complement to a holiday in Kenya; especially as an excellent welcome or farewell dinner.

#### BAAS 5

# 3 Hours Bomas of Kenya

This is a homestead and just a few kilometers from the City, numerous homesteads reflecting Kenya's cocktail of cultures which have been faithfully recreated for visitors to see traditional village life. But the greatest excitement during the afternoon is a visit to the display the traditional dancing music and folklore songs performed in splendid arena.

# THE BIG FIVE



#### BAAS 6

#### Nairobi National Park & Bomas

The National Park, only 8 kms from the city center is Nairobi's pride for no other bustling capital can boast a paradise of wildlife almost on its doorstep. The morning is spent tracking some of the many species found in the park which include Rhino, Lion, Buffalo, Leopard and Cheetah. After lunch at Carnivore Restaurant, continue to Bomas of Kenya for fiesta of traditional music and dances. The tour ends in Nairobi in the early evening.

#### BAAS 7

# Half or Full Day to Paradise Lost (Kiambu Caves)

Leave the madness of the concrete jungle – Nairobi City – and drive to the largest picnic site in Kenya (54 Acres). This is the home of the 2 million years Old Stone Age caves, trees thought to be hundreds of years old while the river reeds have stories to tell. We have nature trails which lead to a silver cut water fall (about 82 different species have been recorded) tour of the 600 acres of coffee, horse riding, riding the "ship" of the desert-camel. Also fishing for black Bass and Tilapia and also boat riding.

#### BAAS 8

# Mt Longonot and Lake Naivasha

Leave Nairobi city — The concrete jungle — and drive westwards stopping at the view point on the Great Rift Valley and view the Loita Plains and also from here you can see Lake Naivasha Sparkling of thousands of feet below. Then proceed to Lake Naivasha (and this is the highest lake in the Rift Valley). Also Lake Naivasha is famous in the 1930's as a staging post for the imperial Airways Flying Boat Services from Durban to London. You can have a boat ride to the Crease Island (an optional activity).

N/B: Crescent Islands is one of the few places in all Africa where you can wander on foot among heard of Zebras, Wildebeests Gazelle and Giraffe – and no predators.

#### BAAS 9

#### Day Trip to the Chimpanzee Sanctuary

Depart Nairobi and travel north, where you drive past pineapple, coffee, banana plantation to one of the largest open air markets in East and Central Africa, Karatina. A brief stopover to sample what is sold and to meet the local inhabitants who belong to the biggest tribe in Kenya – the Kikuyu. Proceed to the Sweet Water Game Reserve / ranch and chimp sanctuary, which is on your way to Mt. Kenya, in time for lunch. Game viewing and visiting the chimps in the one – square kilometer sanctuary.

This sanctuary is home to more than 26 orphaned chimps age varying from 2-15 yeas most of which came from Jane Goodall Institute in Burundi, return to Nairobi in the late evening; (Latest inclusion is baby Zee, rescued from a pet shop in United Arab Emirates).

#### **BAAS 10**

#### One Day to the Birth Place of the Kikuyu Tribe.

After leaving Nairobi drive north passing through by Chania Falls, pineapple plantations, papyrus reeds growing on the roadside, coffee plantation on the way and later, arriving in Murang'a town formerly Fort Hall. (Have lunch at your own pace). Proceed to the sacred tree – the "Mugumo" i.e. fig tree. This area is known by the local dialect ("Mukuruwe-ini wa Nyagathanga") there is a small museum and a guide will give you the history of the Kikuyu cultural traditions e.t.c. Return to Nairobi in the afternoon.

#### **BAAS 11**

# Day Trip - Oldonyo Sabuk National Park

Leave early in the morning and arrive at Thika town then visit Chania falls before you proceed to Fourteen Falls via one of the largest pineapple firms in East Africa (Delmonte). On arrival you need a guide to the falls by an armed ranger because of many buffalos which inhabit the surrounding. (The Hill is known as the local Kamba tribe "Kilimambogo"-

mountain of buffaloes). Return to Nairobi at leisure arriving in the evening.

#### **BAAS 12**

#### **Ngong Hills and Shallom Picnic Site**

The excursion can either be a whole day or half day. And it takes you past the Ngong town and proceed to the top of the hill to a wonderful view of Lake Magadi plains of the Nguruman and Ewaso Nyiro rivers. Lakes Natron etc. Later on, proceed to Shalom picnic site for relaxing and also a place to meet the local people.

#### **BAAS 13**

#### Waljee Nature Trail (1 Day)

Depart Nairobi and drive past Karatina into Mururwe-ini town in time for lunch. Afterwards drive to Waljee camps which is two kilometers from Mukurwe-ini. A guide will lead you to the nature trails where it is home to the rare Barbel and other different species of birds about 220 species recorded. Return to Nairobi late in the evening.

#### **BAAS 14**

# Two Days Kibwezi Forest

**Day 1:** Drive south through the Kapiti Plains on the Nairobi Mombasa Road. Arrive at Kibwezi in time for lunch at Umani springs camp (Luxury) or in your selected camp. There is a waterhole – well maintained to attract wildlife. Explore the nature trails. Return to camp for dinner and overnight. (Budget camp can also be arranged).

**Day 2:** After breakfast return to Nairobi or explore the forest en-route arriving in the evening.

#### **BAAS 15**

# 1 Day: Lake Nakuru National Park

Lake Nakuru lies in the volcano strewn Rift Valley. One of the chain of 8 lakes which stretch the length of Kenya from Tanzania to Ethiopia. The 160 kms drive from Nairobi passes through highland farms of the Kikuyu people before

descending the escarpment into the dramatic landscape of the Rift Valley. Lunch is taken in the Park and is followed by an extensive tour of the park. On the return journey to Nairobi a stop is made at Lake Naivasha where tea is taken among the ever green trees and where bird watchers will be delighted in the fantastic array or bird life.

#### **BAAS 16**

#### **Amboseli National Park**

#### Day 1: Nairobi – Amboseli

A night stop in the park enables a more leisure encounter with the magnificent array of wildlife that is possible on the day of safari. The tour leaves in the morning reaching Amboseli National Park on time for lunch. An afternoon game drive in the area of the permanent swamps which reveal much game, large and small, eminently photogenic in these surrounding. Dinner and overnight at lodge or camp near the park.

#### Day 2: Amboseli – Nairobi

On the second day there is an early morning game drive before leaving for Nairobi arriving in time for lunch.

#### **BAAS 17**

# Tree Hotel: 2 Days

There are "tree hotels" in the vicinity of Nyeri about 100kms North of Nairobi. Treetops and the ark are in the forest of the Aberdare Mountain and Mountain lodge on the slopes of Mt. Kenya.

The drive passes the small industrial town of Thika surrounded by extensive pineapple plantations. After crossing the Tana River, source of much of Kenya's hydro-power, the landscape changes and becomes lusher as you climb in the rich farmlands of the Kikuyu people. Lunch is taken at the Outspan Hotel in Nyeri. Visitors can also visit Treetop Mountain Lodge and the Aberdare Country Club instead of the Ark. In the afternoon proceed to your Tree Hotel where night is spend and where a procession of forest animals visit

the floodlight water holes and saltlicks. Elephant, Rhino, Buffalo, Giant Forest Hog and many other species are present.

#### Day 2: Tree Hotel - Nairobi

In the morning descend to your hotel before returning to Nairobi in time for lunch. Commonly seen.

#### **BAAS 18**

# 3 Days Amboseli

# Day 1: Nairobi / Amboseli

Pick up 0900 hrs from Hotel.

8:30am leave Nairobi and drive South through Maasai Country via Namanga on the Tanzania border and on to Amboseli. On arrival, settle in the camp/lodge. Proceed for a short game drive which provides a chance to see Rhino, Lion, Giraffe, Elephants and many other animals with Mt. Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak providing a beautiful backdrop. Dinner and overnight at the camp.

#### Day 2: Amboseli

Pre-breakfast game drive 6:30hrs – 1100hrs optional activities after breakfast. Afternoon game drive. Dinner and over-night at the camp.

# Day 3. Amboseli/Nairobi

After breakfast leave camp/lodge for the last game drive from 0630 – 0900 hrs, leave Amboseli National Park for Nairobi. Picnic lunch is served en-route. Arrive Nairobi in the afternoon.

#### **BAAS 19**

# 3 Days Maasai Mara

# Day 1: Nairobi/Maasai Mara

0830hrs: Depart from our Nairobi office for a journey south along the floor of the Great Rift Valley. Lunch at Narok and then climb the Western wall entering Hemingway's country; "Serengeti Plains arrive late afternoon in the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Set up a camp or check in a lodge. Early

evening game drive returning to the camp/lodge for dinner and overnight.

#### Day 2: Maasai Mara

A full day spend game viewing across (from 0800 – 1830 hrs) the rich, tree studded grassland and rolling hills the famous Mara is renowned for its great heads of plain's game, back manned Lion, Leopard and Cheetah. It also has numerous Elephants and virtually every type of wildlife to be found in Kenya. All meals and overnight at campsite/lodge.

# Day 3 Maasai Mara /Nairobi

Pre-breakfast game drive from 0630 – 0930hrs back to the camp lodge for the breakfast. Leave Maasai Mara, lunch enroute, arrive In Nairobi later afternoon.

#### **BAAS 20**

# 4 Days Maasai Mara / Nakuru Day 1: Nairobi – Maasai Mara

0830hrs: Drive through rich Kikuyu farmland to the edge of the rift valley, descend the escarpment and drive via Narok to Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Picnic lunch is served en-route. The Maasai Mara joins Tanzania's Serengeti national Park. The Maasai Mara is famous for its black manned Lion and yearly migrations of wild beasts and Zebra, Elephants, Buffalos, Rhino, Gazelle, Leopards, Giraffes also found here 1630 hrs Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

# Day 2: Maasai Mara

A full day spend viewing and exploring this spectacular national park. All the big five can be seen. Maasai Mara is also famous or tis bird life. Meals and overnight at the camp/lodge. (0800hrs – 1800hrs).

# Day 3: Maasai Mara - Nakuru

Pre breakfast game drive 0600-0900hrs. Late breakfast, leave camp and proceed to Nakuru. Dinner and overnight at the hotel camp.

#### Day 4: Lake Nakuru - Nairobi

0800 hrs. After breakfast spend the morning watching and photographing birds and wild animals in the park. After lunch leave for Nairobi stopping for panoramic views of the Great Rift Valley en-route. Arrive at Nairobi in the afternoon.

#### **BAAS 21**

# 4 Days Samburu/Nakuru

# Day 1 Nairobi / Samburu

0830hrs: Drive north via Mt. Kenya past coffee plantations to Samburu Game Reserve Noted for the unusual reticulated Giraffe, Grevy's Zebra, Gerenuk and Somali Ostrich. Picnic lunch and game drive en-route. Dinner and overnight, at the camp/lodge,(1630hrs – 1830 hrs).

#### Day 2: Samburu

Full day in Samburu Game Reserve with early morning (0630 – 0930 hrs and late afternoon game viewing. Meals and overnight at the camp lodge.

# Day 4: Nakuru – Nairobi

After breakfast proceed for game drive in Nakuru National Park. Lunch at 12:00 hrs and depart for Nairobi arriving later afternoon. This itinerary is also available in reverse order.

#### **BAAS 22**

# 4 Days Tsavo West and Chyulu Hills Day 1 Nairobi / Tsavo West

Very early morning leave Nairobi and drive south past kapiti Plains arriving in time for lunch at your camp/lodge. Explore the Tsavo West Park in the afternoon. Return to the camp for dinner and overnight.

# Day 2: Tsavo West

Leave after breakfast and have a game viewing drive, a visit to the Mzima Springs which are not far from the lodges or camps, the pool is rich with hippos, crocodiles and bird life. There is an underwater viewing chamber to give you a view of sub-marine activities. Return to the amp for dinner and overnight. (you will carry packed lunch so that you don't come to the camp).

#### Day 3: Tsavo West

After breakfast visit the Shetani lava Flows and the Chyulu caves (the caves are just outside the chyulu gate). Continue to Chaimu Crater South of Kilanguni Lodge, this can also be trekked (time allowing).

# Day 4: Tsavo West/ Nairobi

After breakfast visit the Ngulia Rhino Sanctuary at the base of Ngulia Hills you have a good chance of seeing the black Rhino (we have about 30). Depart and drive back to Mombasa / Nairobi road on your back to Nairobi lunch en-route.

#### **BAAS 23**

4 Days: Sacred Maasai Shri (Namanga Hills)

# Day 1: Nairobi/Namanga

Depart Nairobi and drive south on the great North Road past the Kapiti plains past the Maasai administrative town of Kajiado. Then proceed on to Bissil town and on the campsite for lunch and prepare your walking gear on the Namanga Hills. Dinner and overnight at the camp.

# Day 2: Namanga Hills

After breakfast start walking / trekking with Maasai Warriors and the resident guide with the equipment for the ritual and the slaughter goat/sheep. All meals at the shrine, one can participate with permission of the elders.

# Day 3: Namanga / Nairobi

Trek down to the camp and then rejoin your transport back to Nairobi either in the afternoon or in time for lunch.

#### **BAAS 24**

# 5 Days Masai Mara / Nakuru

#### Day 1: Nairobi / Maasai Mara

Depart Nairobi at 0830 hrs for Maasai Game reserve. Picnic lunch en-route. Settle in the Camp/lodge.

#### Day 2: Maasai Mara

Full day spend exploring this unique park which really forms the Northern part of the famous Serengeti National Park. Meals and overnight at the Camp/Lodge.

# Day 3: Maasai Mara

Morning game drive - 0630hrs - 0930hrs; afternoon game drive between 1600hrs - 1830hrs. Optional nature walk in between game drive. All meals and overnight at the camp/lodge.

#### Day 4: Maasai Mara / Nakuru

Pre breakfast game drive 0630hrs. Late breakfast, leave camp and proceed to Nakuru. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel/Camp.

N.B. No Game Drive in Nakuru on this day.

# Day 5: Nakuru Nairobi

0800hrs – 1100 hrs; After breakfast, proceed for a game drive. Lunch followed by departure for Nairobi arriving mid or late afternoon.

#### BAAS 25

# Maasai Mara / Lake Nakuru Bogoria and Baringo 6 Days

The Safari takes us South through \*\*\*\*\* 6 Days Rift Valley to Maasai Mara where the largest concentrations of game in Kenya is to be found. Then back North to the remote lake Bogoria and Baringo a bird watchers and naturalists paradise.

# Day 1: Nairobi / Maasai Mara

0830 hrs: Depart from our Nairobi Office for a journey south along the Floor of the great Rift Valley. Lunch served en-

route, then past Narok climb the western wall entering Hemingway's country "Serengeti Plain" Arrive late afternoon in the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Game drive En-route. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

#### Day 2: Maasai Mara

Full day spend in search of Elephant, Zebra, Wild beast, Rhino, Buffalo, Lion Cheetah, Leopard and other plains game. All meals and overnight at the base camp/lodge.

#### Day 3: Maasai Mara

Full day game viewing in the Mara with an optional nature walk or a visit to a nearby Maasai Village in between the meal break. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

# Day 5: Lake Nakuru / Lake Baringo

Morning spend viewing game at lake Nakuru and in the afternoon proceed to Lake Baringo. Those who prefer can organize a boat trip to view the many birds which inhabit this lake at extra cost. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

# Day 6: Lake Bogoria / Nairobi

Explore on foot this nature lake and view the Flamingoes in their thousands. Caution must be taken while walling near the hot springs as these are super-hot. Depart for Nairobi in the afternoon via Nakuru.

#### **BAAS 26**

# 7 Days Maasai Mara / Nakuru/Samburu

# Day 1:- Nairobi / Maasai Mara

0830 hrs: Leave Nairobi for Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Picnic lunch en-route. On arrival proceeds to the campsite/lodge. After a short rest, proceed for a game drive in search of Black manned lions, Elephants Leopards, Cheetah, Buffaloes and other plains game. Return to the camp lodge for dinner and overnight.

# Day 2: Maasai Mara

Full day of game viewing — 0800hrs 1830 hrs with lunch. Dinner and overnight at the camp/hotel

# Day 3: Maasai Mara

0630hrs – 0930hrs; Game drive in the Mara with an optional nature walk or a visit to a nearby Maasai Village in between the meal breaks. Dinner and overnight at the camp/hotel.

#### Day 4: Maasai Mara/Nakuru

0630hrs – 0930hrs: Pre breakfast, game viewing. Leave for Nakuru National Park, game drive and picnic lunch en-route, arriving in Nakuru late in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight at the camp/hotel.

#### Day 5: Nakuru - Samburu

0730hrs; Once in Nakuru, proceed to Nakuru National park for breakfast game drive known for its huge concentration of flamingoes. The park is rich in other bird life and a number of wild animals. After breakfast leave for Samburu. Lunch enroute arriving late afternoon. Dinner an overnight at the campsite/lodge.

#### Day 6: Samburu

0630hrs.After breakfast depart for an early morning game drive. Return to the camp/lodge for lunch 16.00hrs. Another game drive. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

# Day 7 Samburu

Mt Kenya/Nairobi 08:00hrs. After breakfast leave Samburu for Nanyuki at the base of Mt. Kenya for picnic lunch. Drop off clients who want to stay behind to climb Mr. Kenya. After lunch, leave for Nairobi.

Note: Please note that you are required to carry water for this trip.

#### **BAAS 27**

# 7 Days Maasai Mara / Nakuru / Amboseli

# Day 1: Nairobi - Maasai Mara

0830hrs: Leave Nairobi for Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Picnic Lunch en-route. On arrival proceed to the campsite / lode.

After a short rest, proceed for a game drive in search of Black manned lion, Elephants, Leopards, Cheetah, Buffaloes and other plain's game. Return to the camp for dinner and overnight stay.

#### Day 2: Maasai Mara

Full day games drive — 08:00hrs 18:30hrs which picnic lunch. Dinner and overnight at the camp/hotel

#### Day 3: Maasai Mara

06:30hrs – 10:00hrs; Full day game viewing in the Mara with an optional nature walk or afternoon fame driver or a visit to a nearby Maasai village in between the meal breaks. 16:00hrs – 1830hrs: Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge

#### Day 4: Maasai Mara - Nakuru

0830hrs: After an early game drive, leave Maasai Mara for Nakuru National Park. Picnic Lunch en-route. No game drive in Nakuru on this day.

# Day 5: Nakuru – Nairobi Amboseli

0730hrs – 0930hrs: After breakfast morning game drive. Lunch en-route. Once in the National Park proceed to shot game drive en-route to camp. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

# Day 6; Amboseli

0630hrs. Proceed for an early morning game drive. Return to camp/lodge for breakfast 1530hrs. After lunch a further game drive. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

# Day 7 Amboseli - Nairobi.

After breakfast leave camp/lodge for the last game drive as you leave Amboseli National park for Nairobi 0630 – 0900hrs. Picnic lunch served en-route. Arrive Nairobi in the afternoon.

#### **BAAS 28**

#### 8 Days Turkana special

# Day 1: Nairobi - Baringo

0830hrs; Leave Nairobi for Lake Baringo. Picnic lunch enroute on arrival at Lake Baringo in the afternoon, set up camp/check in at a lodge. Those who prefer can organize for a boat trip to see the many birds on the island. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

#### Day 2: Baringo – Maralal - South Horr

0700hrs: After breakfast leave Baringo for Maralal. Picnic lunch en-route. A walk after lunch through the most colorful town, before proceeding to Baragoi via Isiolo which is on the edge of the Great. Rift Valley. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

# Day 3 South Horr - Lake Trukana

# Day 4 Lake Turkana

After breakfast visit the El-molo village. Lunch at camp site/Lodge. Afternoon leisure, fishing or swimming if the crocodiles permit! The visit to the El-Molo village is available at an extra cost. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

# Day 5: Turkana - Maralal

0900hrs: After breakfast leave Turkana for Maralal. Lunch enroute. Dinner and overnight at Maralal in the camp/lodge.

# Day 6: Maralal - Samburu

0830hrs: After breakfast leave Maralal for Samburu Game Reserve. On arrival proceed to the campsite / lodge and thereafter proceed for a late evening game drive, return to the car lodge for dinner and overnight.

# Day 7 Samburu

0630hrs: Early morning game drive. Return to the camp/lodge for lunch at 1:00pm. Further game drive from 4:00p.m Up to 6:00pm. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

Depart Nairobi for Samburu Game Reserve on our way to Samburu drive via Nanyuki town for lunch, passing through very pleasant country-side with coffee & tea plantations with good view of the peaks of Mt. Kenya in dear weather. Set up camp dinner and overnight camp dinner and overnight camp.

#### Day 2 Samburu

Morning & afternoon game viewing in Samburu with lunch and leisure break at camp in the mid-afternoon. During the leisure break you can visit a nearby lodge for swimming, visiting the Samburu people all at an extra cost. All meals and overnight camp.

# Day 3 Samburu - Marsabit

Early morning pre-breakfast, game drive. After breakfast depart for Marsabit via the signing well of the Borana tribe which is quite a colorful ceremony; as they also bring their livestock to water at the same time later lunch at camp then spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the camp site.

# Day 4 Marsabit - Kalacha

After breakfast proceed on a game drive in the nearby Marsabit National Park including a stop at "Lake Paradise" which is a natural water hole in this park which is essentially an Oasis. Drive on to Kalacha picnic lunch en-route. Dinner

and overnight at the camp site in this tiny settlement at the edge of the Chalbi Desert.

#### Day 5 Kalacha – Lake Turkana

After breakfast depart Kalacha for Loiyangaiani. The summon term used for the South-Eastern shore of L. Turkana cross the Chalbi desert, also by passing North Horn Lunch on arrival; Rest for the afternoon at leisure for a well deserved rest having crossed Chalbi. Dinner and overnight at the campsite.

# Day 6 Lake Turkana

A full day at the shores of Lake Turkana during which you can visit the El-Molo tribesman in the village who are said to be the smallest tribe in Africa, at an extra cost. Rest for the day. Caution should be exercised near the lake as its waters are Crocodile invested. All meals overnight at the campsite.

#### Day 7 Lake Turkan – Maralal

After breakfast depart from Loiyangaiani for Maralal town, viewing picturesque and pristine desert landscape and scenery and the varous nomadic tribes that inhibit the northern park of Kenya grazing their livestock which includes camels, Lunch en-route. Dinner and overnight at campsite.

# Day 8: Maralal – Nairobi via Thomson falls

After breakfast, depart Maralal for Nairobi via Thomson falls which lunch en-route. Arrive in Nairobi early evening.

# Day 1: Nairobi – Maasai Mara

#### Day 8: Samburu

After breakfast, depart for an early morning in game drive. Return to the camp/lodge for lunch. 1600hrs. another game drive, dinner and overnight at the campsite/lodge.

#### Day 11: Amboseli

Early morning game drive before breakfast. After breakfast have a whole day game viewing. Optional

Maasai Village visit

Nature walk

Swimming in one of the lodges

(All at extra cost) return for Dinner and overnight at the campsite/lodge.

# Day 13: Tsavo West - Tsavo East

After breakfast, drive to Tsavo East which is renowned for its large numbers of elephants and the famous man eating Lions (during the building of the Kenya/Uganda railway in 1890) Lunch on arrival. Game drive. Dinner and overnight at the campsite/lodge

# Day 14: Leave Tsavo East either to Mombasa or Nairobi

#### **BAAS 31**

#### Loita (Maji Moto) - Nguruma

#### 6 Days

This is an eco-tourism related program for those in search of adventure while on foot and coming face to face with plans game and the Maasai people.

#### Day 1

Depart Nairobi passing through the Rift Valley to Narok Town. After half hours' drive from here you will be dropped at maji Moto. A Swahili word meaning hot water. Proceed on the Ndarara manyattas for lunch. Walk for 72 hours to Ndarara camp for dinner and overnight (this is not an established camp, but a makeshift camp as you assist your guide with pitching them up)

# Day 2:

After breakfast leave Ndarara to Letukunyi, this walk will take you 5-6 hrs through the scattered bushes, Dinner and overnight at Letukunyi.

#### Day 3

Depart Letukunyi early enough before the sun is too hot and pass to Narosora for lunch or purchase what might be out of stock!! After some time with the Maasai in this modern Maasai town proceed to Morinjo for dinner and overnight in a selected area.

# Day 4

Leave Morinjo and walk through the forest (this is one of the few remaining true forestry wilderness area in East Africa) this walk take you 5-6 hrs. Dinner and overnight at Enkutuo Camp.

# Day 5

We have two options;

(i) Leave Enkuto and pass along the left side of the Rift Valley via the Nguruman Escarpment to

- Nguruman Town for Dinner and overnight at a local hotel
- (ii) Or leave Enkututo not too early, walk leisurely for 4-5 hrs to Njoroi campsite for dinner and overnight. This camp has an excellent view of the surrounding area which include Lake Magadi, Ngong Hills, Lake Natron in Tanzania on a clear day.

#### Day 6

After breakfast descend down the escarpment and through small firms to Nguruman Town for our journey back to Nairobi via Lake Magadi and Olgaaile Prehistoric sites sand arrive in Nairobi late afternoon.

Arrive Namanga border town at 10.00hrs. After immigration formalities, continue to Arusha for lunch. Proceed to

Ngorongoro for overnight on the crater rim. Dinner and overnight at Ngorongoro Wildlife lodge, or campsite.

#### Day 2: Ngorongoro

#### Day 4: Tarangire-Nairobi

After breakfast, drive to Arusha / Mto wa Mbu village for shopping of Makonde carvings and other souvenirs. After lunch in Arusha drive to Nairobi via Namanga border town, arriving early evening.

# 4 Days: Manyara /Ngorongoro Day 1: Nairobi-Lake Manyara

#### Day 4 Ngorongoro-Nairobi.

After breakfast leave Ngorongoro for Arusha. We will stop at Mto wa Mbwe village for shopping of souvenirs arriving in time for lunch. Drive to Nairobi via Namanga border town arriving early evening.

Full day crater tour with break for Lunch at Ngoitoktok springs picnic site. The main crater is 165km and contains constant animals population of varied species. Black manned Lions, Rhino/buffaloes Elephants and other Grazing animals have made this crater a permanent home. Return early evening to Ngorongoro wildlife lodge or campsite for dinner and overnight.

# Day 3: Ngorongoro-serengeti

0730hrs: Leave Ngorongoro after breakfast for Olduvai George. Lunch at Gorge Museum. After lunch, visit various sites of the Gorge Museus. After lunch, visit various sites of the Gorge to see where the remains of prehistoric man were discovered by the famous archeologist Dr.L.S.B Leakey. Visit an old Maasai home on the way. Proceed to Serengeti plains

past Seronera and on to Lobo, with afternoon game viewing. Dinner and overnight at Lobo Wildlife Lodge or campsite.

#### Day 4: Serengeti

Leave Lobo for Ndutu with game viewing in Serengeti and a round Ndutu woodlands to locate leopards and numerous plains games as well as cheetahs, common species here. Overnight at Ndutu safari lodge or campsite.

#### Day 2: Moshi- Mandara Hut

After breakfast, drive 45kms to Marangu gate an altitude of 1,860m. Walk to Mandara hut,2,744m(9000 ft) through dense semi-tropical rain forest, for your first overnight on Kilimanjaro. meals and overnight at the hut.

# Day 3: Mandara-Horombo Hut

Start early morning for a ten hours walk towards Horombo. The landscape becomes, more rugged and rocky but superb, both Mawenzi and Kibo peaks in view. You spend you second night at the mountain at Horombo hut, an altitude of 3,761m(12,335ft).

#### Day 4: Horombo-Kibo Hut

Take a tiring 13km which takes 6hrs to Kibo hut 4132m (15,520 ft) above sea level. Spectacular mountain vegetation like giant cactus, grounds well and lobelia appear. Meals and overnight at the hut.

#### Day 5: Kibo-Uhuru Peak-Horombo Hut

The final attempt to the summit is made in the early hours of the morning at 0200hrs.it takes about 5hours to climb the steepest and most difficult part of the route to Oilman's point(5,681m)18,630 ft. From Oilman's it take 1 to 2 hours to Uhuru peak,8,896m(19,344ft) Descend to Horombo for dinner and overnight.

# Day 6: Horombo-Moshi

Descent is rapid. After breakfast, drive to Arusha for Lunch, then to Nairobi via Anmantfa border town arriving early in the evening.

# Day 7: Moshi -/Nairobi

After breakfast, leave by morning shuttle to arrive Nairobi early afternoon.

#### **BAAS 42**

#### **8 Days Machame Route**

#### Day 1: Nairobi-Arusha

Pick up at Nairobi hotel at 0700hrs. O800hrs . Leave for Arusha by a tourist shuttle bus via Namanga boarder town .Arrive in time for lunch. Afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight at a hotel.

#### Day 2: Arusha-Machame

Continue East towards Kibo passing the junction, then East towards the Lara towers. Shortly after this, you climb down to Barranco hut.(3940m)Dinner and overnight.

# Day 5: Barranco/Bararu

From Barranco a steep rocky climb, passing the Barranco wall, then up and down until you come to Karanga Valley and then on to Barafu hut(4,600). Dinner and overnight in tents.

# Day 6: Barafu/Mweka/horombo

Very early start for the summit, first to Stella point and then to Uhuru peak(5896m)There are through ways to descend on this route-Marangu or Mweka. The Mweka hut will take about 6 hours. The route is steep but picture sque. The Marangu route-Uhuru-Kibo-Horombo is the main route. It is easier but can be dusty and busy .It is also longer.

#### Day 7:Mweka/Horombo/Arusha

Mweka hut to Mweka gate will take about 3 hours. horombo Maeangu gate will take about 6 hours. Drive to Arusha for hot showers, dinner and warm bed.

#### Day 8:Arusha/Nairobi

After breakfast leave for Nairobi by morning or afternoon shuttle bus where the tour ends.

#### **BAAS 43**

#### 8 Days Kilimanjaro Climb Umbwe route

#### Day 1: Nairobi-Arusha

Leave Nairobi for Arusha by shuttle bus arriving in time for lunch. Afternoon spent at leisure and shopping for the previsions needed for the mountain. Dinner and overnight in an Arusha hotel.

#### Day 2: Arusha-Lava Caves

Alter breakfast, transfer to Marangu gate and then to Umbwe village to start to climb. Climb for four hours through the rain forest to ramp at the caves 2800m above the sea level.

# Day 3: Lava caves –Barranco Hut

After breakfast, continue ascending along a sharp ridge, giving a distinct high mountain feeling, then unto the Moorland Camp and by midafternoon stay at Barranco hut 3900m.


# Day 4: Barranco Hut-Arrow Glacier-;

A four hour walk past enormous breach wall to camp at the foot of the Arow Glacier. A leisurely afternoon and evening acclimatizing at around 4900m and watching the sunset behind Mt. Meru.

# Day 5: Arrow Glacier-Kilimanjaro Crater Rim

Climbing the same steep scrambling up the screens and across the frozen lava on im tottering wall. We camp on the stunning crater rim of Kilimanjaro.

#### Day 6: Kilimanjaro Crater Rim/horombo Hut

You trek up the highest point in Africa, Uhuru peak(5896m). Descend via Oilman's point and Kobe Hut for dinner and overnight.

#### Day 7: Horombo /Arusha

After breakfast descend to the Marango park gate via Mandara. You will be transferred to Arusha for dinner and overnight stay.

#### Day 8: Arusha/Nairobi

After breakfast leave for Nairobi by morning or afternoon shuttle bus where the tour ends.

Climbing to the big y then to saddle Hut (3570m) later back to saddle Hut for dinner and overnight .A hike up to the little Meru is done in the afternoon hours.

# Day 03:

Final ascent to the Mt. Meru peak (4566m) descend down to Saddle Hut then to Mariam mba hut for dinner and overnight

# Day 04:

Walk solely to Momella gate arrival by 10.30 am and transfer to Arusha.






