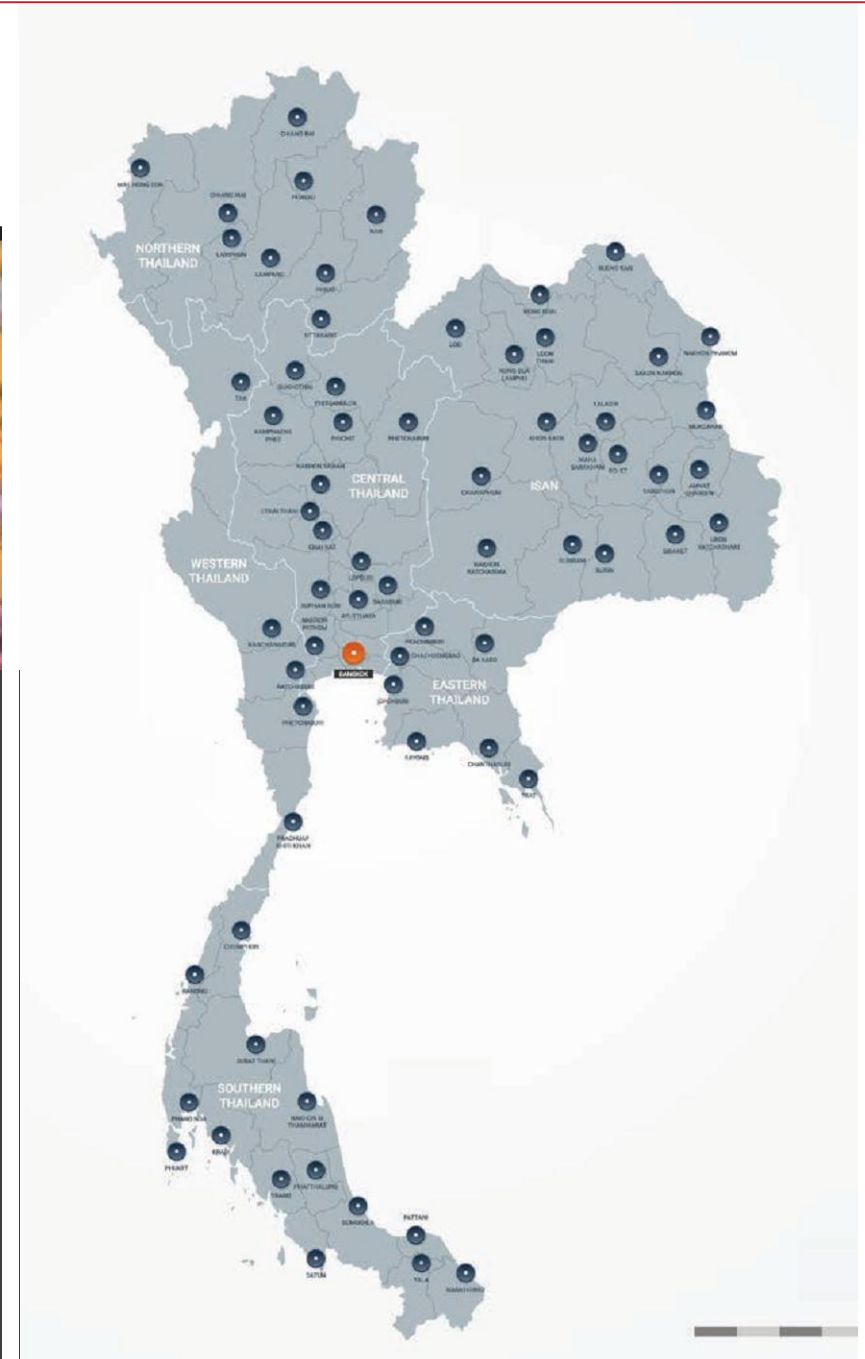




# Why Thailand?

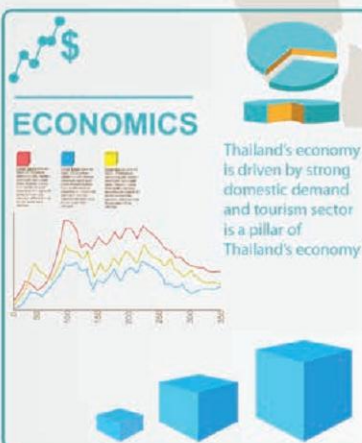
There are various transportation options provided for tourists – by land, by air, and by boat but also many local transport options that provide unique experiences for travelers

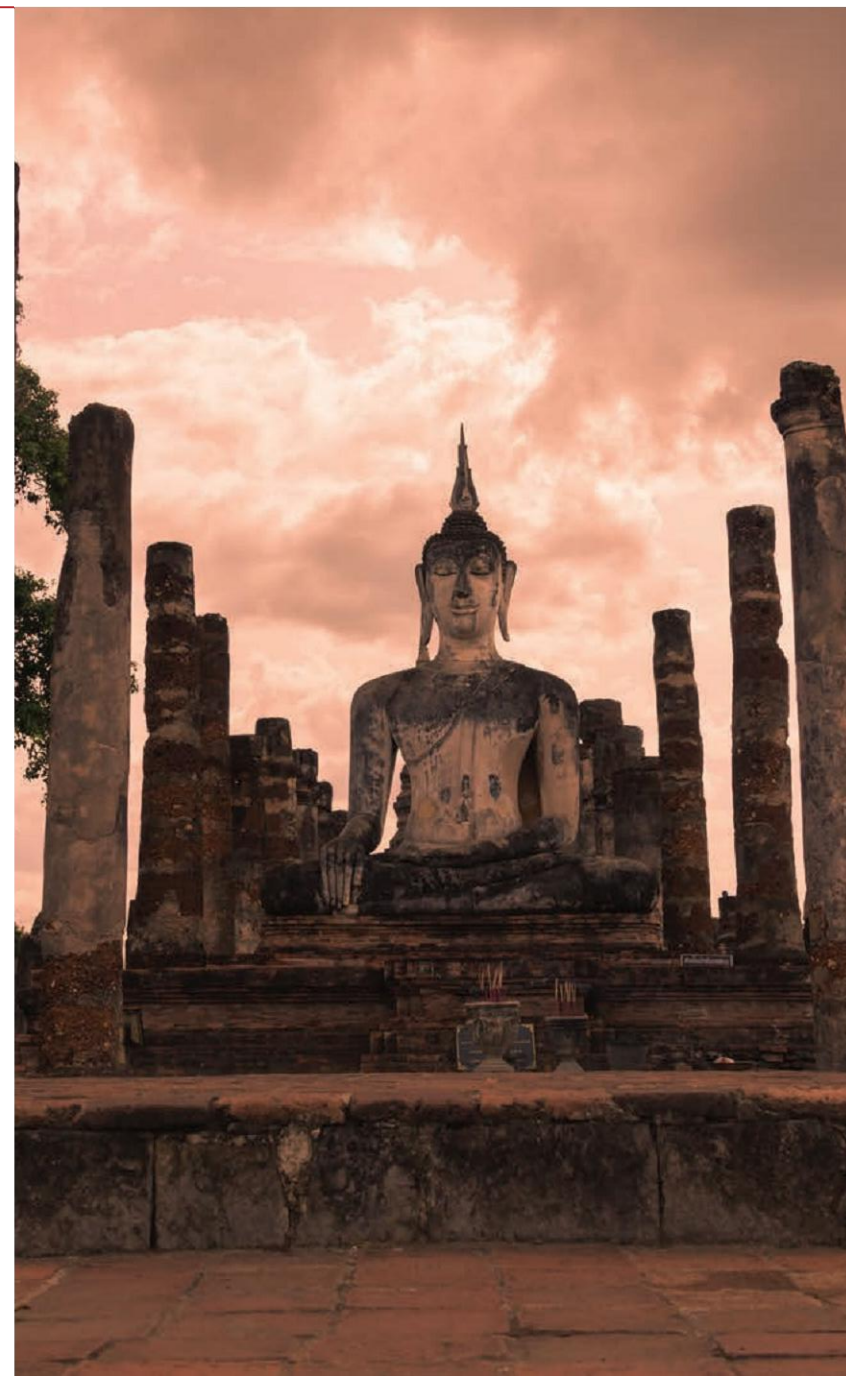




# The Temples

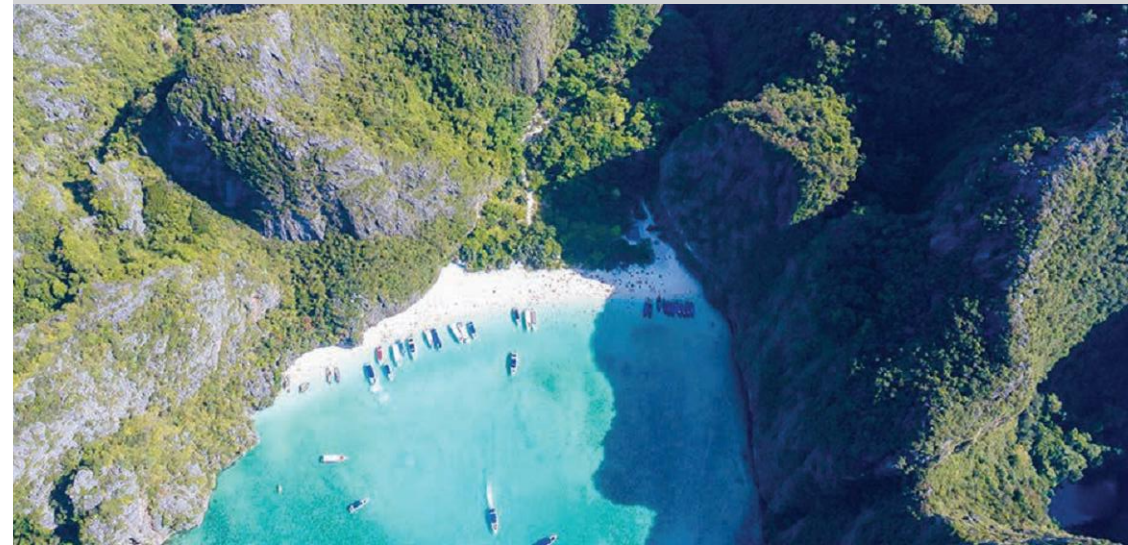


# Markets & Beaches
